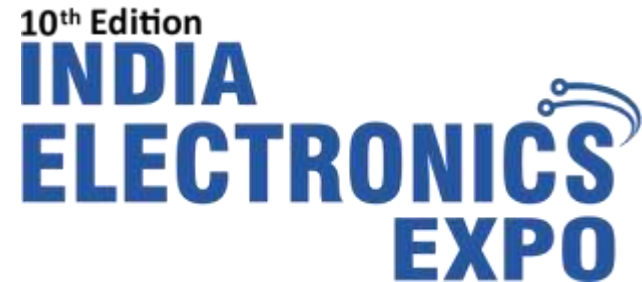

Key Learnings



Lack of Awareness:

Observation: Media seemed unaware of IndiaSoft or India Electronics Expo.

Insight: There was a need for continuous and sustained public relations efforts throughout the year to build awareness and engagement in advance of the event.



Reactive Approach:

Observation: Many activities were conducted as an afterthought, including out-of-home (OOH) advertising and radio activations.

Insight: A more proactive approach is necessary to ensure all aspects of the event are well-planned and executed on time.



Media Partners:

Observation: There was a lack of clarity regarding ESC's interest in media partnerships.

Insight: Early engagement with potential media partners could ensure better coverage across TV, radio, print, digital, and social media platforms.



Integrated Communications:

Observation: Successful events require integrated communication strategies across various platforms.

Insight: Improvements can be made in the quality of content and visuals across digital, social, and website platforms. For instance, the Convergence Expo website serves as a good example, whereas our websites hadn't even updated the "all rights reserved" year.



Panelist Selection:

Observation: Some panelists lacked appeal among the younger generation and media such as Aman Gupta, Sanjeev Bikhchandani, etc.

Insight: Choosing panelists who resonate with younger audiences and have media popularity can increase engagement and visibility.

Suggestions



Continuous PR and Pre-Event Buzz

Implement ongoing PR efforts throughout the year and create sustained buzz well in advance of the event to enhance media awareness and engagement.



Proactive Planning

Develop a proactive planning strategy for all event activities, including OOH advertising, radio activations, and more. Ensure that all aspects are meticulously planned and executed ahead of time.



Early Media Partner Engagement

Start engaging media partners much earlier to secure guaranteed coverage across multiple platforms (TV, Radio, Print, Digital, Social). This will ensure a wider reach and better visibility for the event.



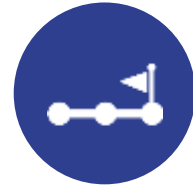
Enhance Integrated Communications

Incorporate integrated communications strategies encompassing digital, social, website, and media channels. Improve the quality of content and visuals across all platforms. Regularly update the website to maintain a professional image.



Select Engaging Panelists

Choose panelists who are popular among the younger generation and have a good presence in the media. This will enhance audience engagement and attract media attention.



Phase-Wise Approach

Adopt a phase-wise approach towards the event, including pre-event announcements, comprehensive during-event coverage, and post-event sustenance activities. Highlight key metrics such as footfall, visibility, and sales to measure and communicate event success.



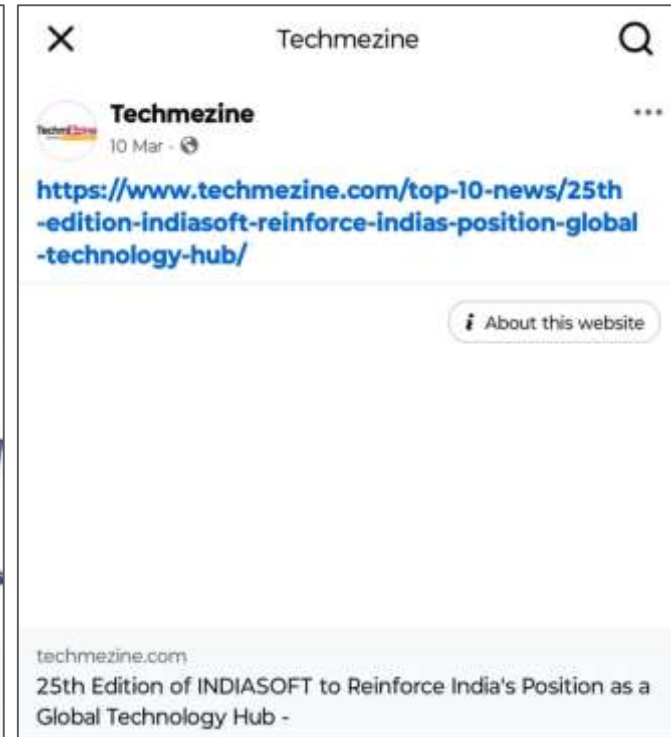

This marks a 3.63 per cent increase from the \$193 billion recorded in the previous year, according to a report by the Electronics and [Computer Software](#) Export Promotion Council (ESC).

The report also sheds light on the regional contribution to software exports across India.

The southern region remains the largest contributor, accounting for \$131.1 billion, which is about 65.55 per cent of the total exports.

The western region follows with \$34.1 billion (17.05 per cent), while the northern region contributes \$30.78 billion (15.39 per cent). The eastern region has the smallest share, with \$4.02 billion (2.01 per cent).

India's IT and electronics industry has seen remarkable growth, attracting major global companies due to its skilled workforce, cost advantages, and a favourable business environment, the report said.

The rise of new technologies like artificial intelligence, machine learning, and cloud computing is further boosting India's status as a global digital leader.

"India's skilled managerial and technical workforce is meeting global standards, particularly in the IT sector, which is transforming the country into the world's outsourcing hub," ESC Chairman Veer Sagar said.

भारत का सॉफ्टवेयर और आईटी सेवाओं का निर्यात वित्त वर्ष 2023-24 में बढ़कर 200 बिलियन डॉलर तक पहुंच गया। यह पिछले वर्ष के 193 बिलियन डॉलर की तुलना में 3.63% की वृद्धि है। इस रिपोर्ट को इलेक्ट्रॉनिक्स और कंप्यूटर सॉफ्टवेयर एक्सपोर्ट प्रमोशन काउंसिल (ईएससी) ने जारी किया है।

भारत की आईटी इंडस्ट्री की इस सफलता का मुख्य कारण यहां की कुशल वर्कफोर्स, कम लागत, और अनुकूल कारोबारी माहौल है। इसके अलावा, आर्टिफिशियल इंटेलिजेंस (AI), मशीन लर्निंग और क्लाउड कंप्यूटिंग जैसी नई तकनीकों के कारण भी भारत की स्थिति मजबूत हुई है।

भारत का सबसे बड़ा आईटी सेवा निर्यात बाजार अमेरिका है, जिसने 109.40 बिलियन डॉलर (54.70%) का आयात किया। इसके बाद यूके (28.70 बिलियन डॉलर, 14.35%), सिंगापुर (7 बिलियन डॉलर, 3.50%), और चीन (5.50 बिलियन डॉलर, 2.75%) हैं।

ईएससी के चेयरमैन वीर सागर ने कहा कि भारत का आईटी क्षेत्र वैश्विक मानकों को पूरा कर रहा है और देश को दुनिया के आउटसोर्सिंग हब में बदल रहा है। उन्होंने यह भी बताया कि सॉफ्टवेयर प्रोडक्ट्स, बीपीओ सेवाओं और क्लाउड टेक्नोलॉजी की बढ़ती मांग से भारत की डिजिटल अर्थव्यवस्था को और मजबूती मिलेगी।

विशेषज्ञों का मानना है कि भारत की आईटी इंडस्ट्री आने वाले वर्षों में और आगे बढ़ेगी और देश ग्लोबल डिजिटल लीडर बनने की ओर अग्रसर रहेगा।

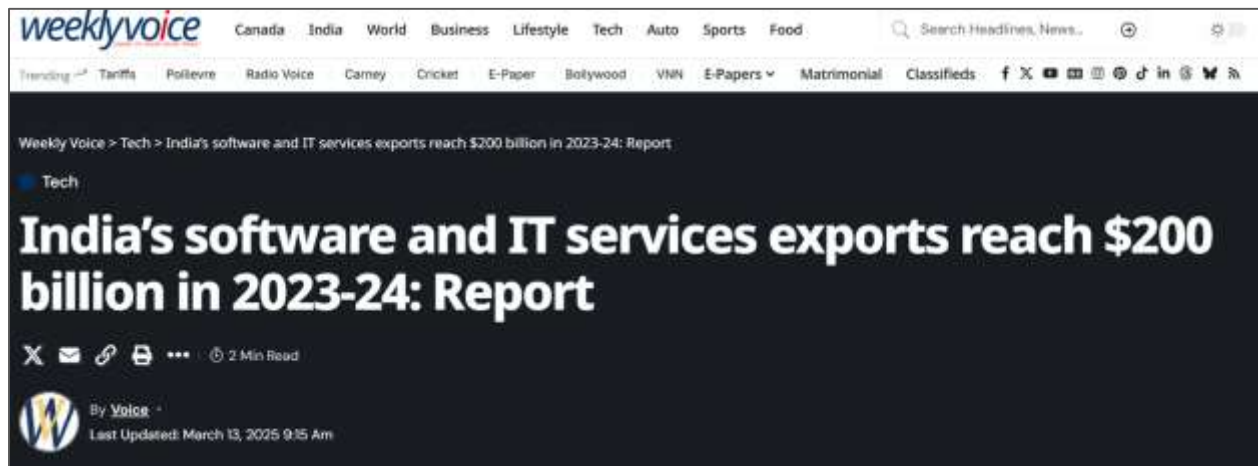

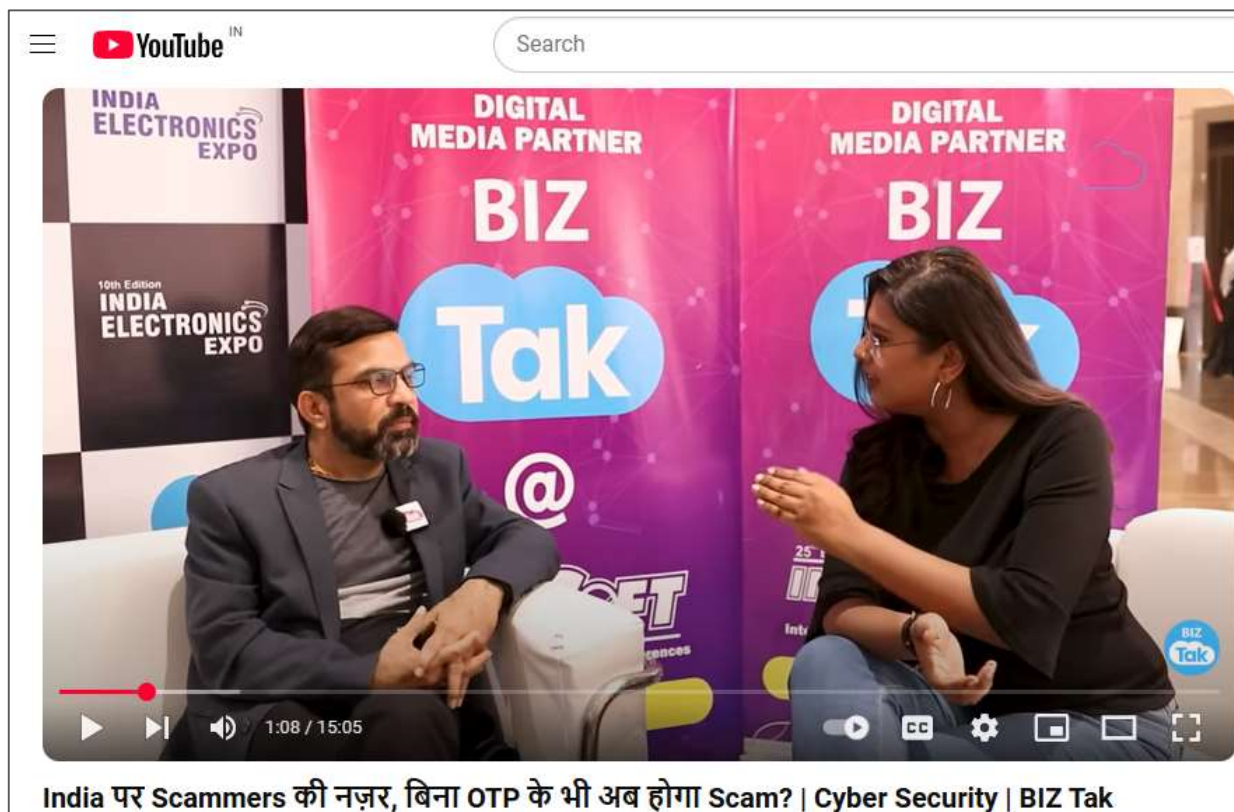

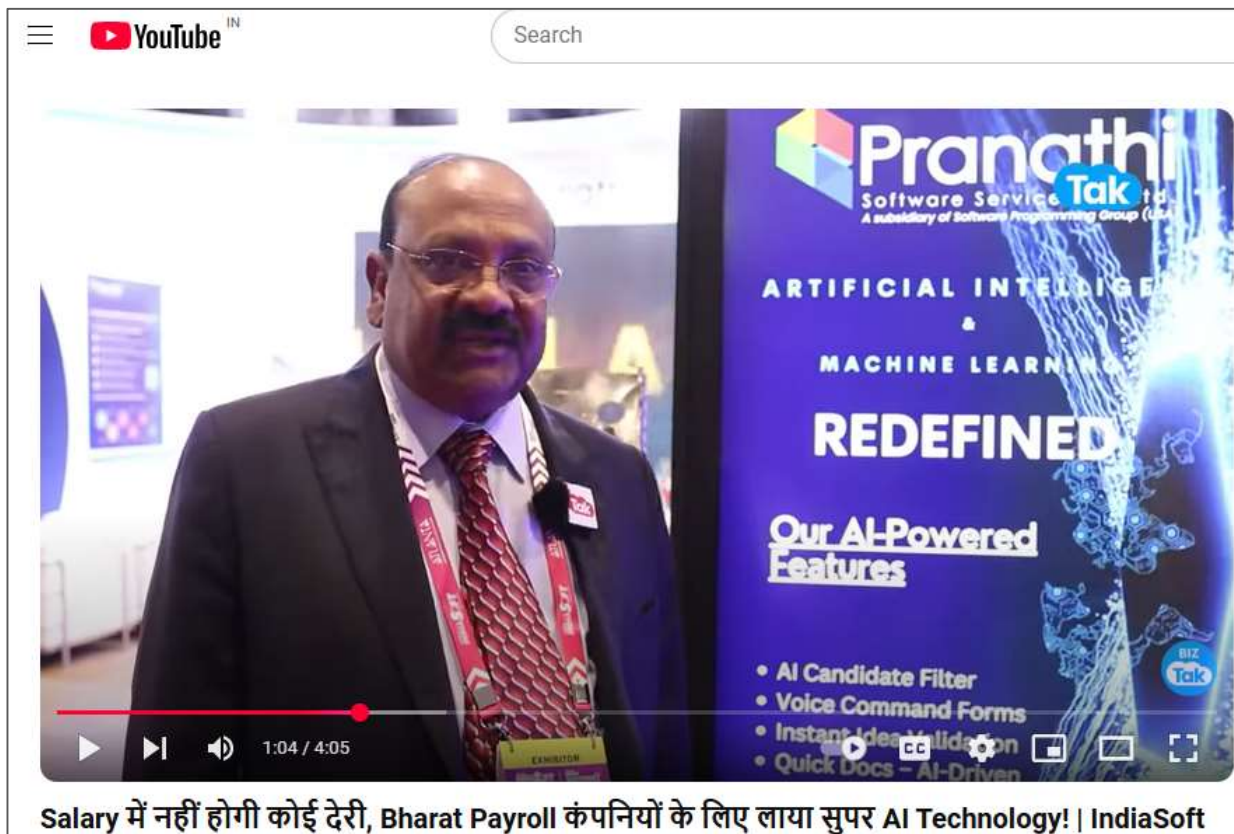
